## Friendly Reminder

**Plumbing Tip:** Why is there sometimes an odor emanating from the bathroom floor drain? The most common reason is that the "trap" in the floor drain has no water in it. Most restrooms on upper floors of the buildings have floor drains designed to collect water in the event of a toilet overflow or leak. These drains are plumbed with a trap, which must always have water inside it to prevent sewer smells from escaping up through the drain. Mopping pushes water into the drain and, when done on a regular basis, will typically prevent unpleasant smells. A more proactive measure to prevent the trap from drying up would be to occasionally pour a cup of water into the floor drain, sometimes adding an ounce or two of vegetable oil or mineral oil to keep the water from evaporating.
