Fun facts about the historic Cummings Center site, formerly known as "The Shoe"

The original plans for The Shoe included three buildings: A and B were to be 60 feet wide and 520 feet long, with C being somewhat shorter. The facility was to include 10 acres of floor space, and 90 percent of the walls were to be made of clear glass. Although the end result was still three buildings, once fully constructed, The Shoe was almost double the size of initial projections.
