Talking Trash



Cummings actively seeks to keep trash removal costs low for its client firms, regularly drawing on its purchasing power to negotiate favorable contracts as market conditions evolve. Our present contract is nearing its term, and we have been advised to expect a meaningful rate increase in January.

Ongoing supply chain issues, landfill closures, and assorted legislative restrictions continue to drive up operating costs for waste management firms

nationwide, resulting in higher rates for the consumer. We encourage all clients, whether their disposal services are handled independently or through Cummings, to plan for increased waste disposal fees as they budget for the new year. Cummings' new rates will be shared with clients once they have been finalized.

In the meantime, changing habits can pay dividends. Consider adopting some of the following practices to cut down on the amount of waste your firm needs to dispose of.


