The Latest at Cummings



Beverly's Cummings Center campus was recently the setting of a global feel-good news story when a large gray seal, affectionately dubbed "Shoebert" by locals, installed itself in Shoe Pond. Animal enthusiasts, reporters, and other curious individuals flocked to the scene hoping to catch a glimpse of the unusual visitor-and he did not disappoint. After a full week of bullishly evading all attempts to be guided back to the ocean, Shoebert climbed out of the pond, made his way to Beverly Police Department,

and allowed local authorities to transport him to Mystic, CT (where he had previously been tagged) for a checkup and safe reintroduction to the wild.

Friendly Reminders



Disposal Procedure: Clients leaving oversized or inappropriate waste on loading docks or in dumpsters will be billed on a time and materials basis, with a minimum fee of \$350. Please keep the loading docks clear **at all times**.

As a reminder, clients are responsible for the disposal of all office furniture, pallets, shipping crates, and other large items. You are welcome to make use of the dumpster behind 3 Cummings Park for free wood pallet and packing crate disposal.

Additionally, hazardous materials such as chemicals, medical waste, and automotive batteries should not be discarded in dumpsters.

Flu Tips: Flu season has begun. Here are several ways to decrease the risk of spreading influenza and other illnesses in the workplace:

- Get the flu vaccine, especially if you have a condition that makes health complications from the flu more likely.
- Regularly clean frequently touched items, such as door handles, phones, faucets, keyboards, and copiers.
- Frequently wash hands with soap and water or an alcoholbased hand gel.
- Cough or sneeze into a clean tissue or the inside of your elbow.
- Avoid close contact with others who have a cold or the flu.

Talking Trash: Thank you, in advance, for observing the following trash removal guidelines.

- To prevent unsightly carpet stains and burns, all trash bags and barrels should be carried or carted—not dragged—over carpeted floors.
- Please remember that the trash compactor is for regular office waste only.
- When trash is placed in one of the compactors, the compactor ram *must* be operated to prevent overflows and jams.
- Please do not leave unwanted items, such as furniture or other large items, in or near the compactors, or on any of the loading docks.
- Also remember that all cardboard boxes or materials need to be broken down before being placed into recycling dumpsters or bins. This will help maximize capacity, as well as greatly assist our recycling efforts.
