Cummings Center Walking Tour More than two dozen people stepped back in time during a January 16 walking tour of Cummings Center that included a discussion of the history of United Shoe Machinery Company (USMC). The one-hour tour was developed and led by Abby Battis, associate director for collections at Historic Beverly and adjunct faculty member at Harvard University Extension School, which includes 15 stops on the first floor of the 100 building. A newly developed second tour, scheduled for Wednesday, February 6 at 6:00 PM, will cover the remainder of the first floor of the 100 building as well as a portion of 900 Cummings Center.
