Campus Update



New Police Station Construction to Begin: Cummings Center patrons may have noticed increased activity in the south parking lot between Route 62, East Garage, and the Marblehead Bank/People's United Bank ATM building. Cummings Properties donated those two acres of land to the city of Beverly in 2001 for a public safety building. Now, some 19 years later, the city is mobilizing to construct a three-story, more than 30,000-square-foot state-of-the-art police station.

Starting this week, we expect the City's contractor will (a) install Jersey barriers along Route 62, (b) close the eastern most entrance to Cummings Center from Route 62 (i.e., the entrance closest to the MBTA tracks), and (c) install construction fencing around the remainder of the public safety parcel. The ATM building will remain accessible at all times during construction, and periodically, some Cummings Center parking spaces proximate to the construction zone will be temporarily blocked to facilitate construction operations. It is anticipated that the new facility will be operational in 2021.
