# **Shoe Snippets**

Fun facts about the historic Cummings Center site, formerly known as "The Shoe"

The health and safety of the men and women working at The Shoe were vital to maintaining efficiency. The Shoe's leadership saw sunlight and fresh air as key components to the wellbeing and happiness of employees. "Light is food. So is air. We have provided plenty of both," said a USMC official at the time. Between 75 and 90 percent of the walls at The Shoe were made of glass to provide light, and the buildings were constructed with fans that removed dust and other impurities to ensure clean air.
