Drawbridge Update: The MBTA's plans to complete a rehabilitation of the Beverly Drawbridge are in full swing, including full replacement of the hydraulic rail system, bridge wedges, and swing span motor and mechanisms. This work will require a shutdown of rail service along the Newburyport/Rockport Commuter Rail Lines from July 16 through August 13, with regular train service scheduled to resume on August 14.
