# **Scenes From "The Shoe"**

A window into the historic Cummings Center site, formerly home to United Shoe Machinery Co.



At its peak, The Shoe employed 9,000 workers and produced 85 percent of all shoemaking machines in the U.S. By 1910, it had acquired an 80 percent share of the market with assets valued at \$40 million.
