# **Friendly Reminders**



Minifridge Fire Hazard: Nearly 900,000 popular minifridges were recalled this summer for fire and burn hazards following numerous reported injuries and combined property damage exceeding \$1 million. Details about the recalled AstroAI- and Frigidaire-branded units are available from

<u>U.S. Consumer Product Safety Commission</u>.

Please be mindful of leaving portable electronics running while unattended, especially during nights and weekends when the space is unoccupied.

**Protect the Flooring:** Please be careful not to damage the carpet when moving furniture and materials within a suite or along common hallways. Items should never be *dragged* on carpeting, as doing so frequently creates permanent, unsightly friction burns that necessitate costly carpet replacement.

Similarly, we ask that all clients use a protective pad or mat beneath rolling chairs. Damage from the frequent rolling of chairs,



even when limited to a small section of carpeting, often requires a much larger replacement.

Thank you for helping to prevent unnecessary maintenance charges.

**Video Recording**: Numerous video cameras are installed throughout Cummings' portfolio and are used regularly to record activity at various



building entryways, hallways, and other common areas. Most of these cameras are *not* actively monitored and are in use primarily for law enforcement officials to review video footage in the event of an incident. Anyone observing suspicious activity at any time is urged to

immediately contact the local authorities by calling 911. While uniformed or plainclothes police officers sometimes patrol Cummings' buildings and grounds, please remember that Cummings Properties does *not* provide security services.






