Don't Be Alarmed: Fire alarm testing will occur throughout the Cummings Center and Dunham Ridge campuses **beginning on Tuesday, June 1 and continuing through Wednesday, June 23**, starting at approximately 7:00 AM. The schedule is as follows:

- 100 Cummings Center Tuesday and Wednesday, June 1 and 2, and Monday and Tuesday, June 7 and 8
- 500 Cummings Center Wednesday, June 9 and Thursday, June 10

- 200 and 800 Cummings Center Tuesday, June 15
- 900 and 950 Cummings Center and parking garages Thursday, June 17
- 600 Cummings Center Friday, June 18
- 50 Dunham Ridge Tuesday, June 22
- 48 Dunham Ridge and parking garage Wednesday, June 23
