**Mulch is Flammable:** It is essential that all cigarettes be fully extinguished and disposed of properly. *Never* toss cigarette butts into landscaped areas, as bark mulch is flammable. Improperly disposed of cigarettes are a frequent source of landscape fires, which can quickly spread to buildings and vehicles, causing needless damage. **Don't Be Alarmed:** Required fire alarm system testing will continue throughout Cummings Center and Dunham Ridge according to the schedule below. Testing will start at approximately 6:30 AM, and warning alarms and strobe lights will be activated. Personnel may access client spaces as needed to check device operation.
