Friendly Reminders

Janitorial

Standard janitorial services are provided in office areas (only) at 300 and 400 TradeCenter, at no charge, after business hours Monday through Friday (excluding holidays). The following janitorial services are performed daily:

- replacing light bulbs and liners for wastebaskets, as needed
- removal of normal office trash and emptying of wastebaskets
- recycling of all paper materials from blue desk-side recycling containers (only)
- dusting of all readily accessible horizontal surfaces
- cleaning of glass entries, doors, and sidelights
- cleaning of restrooms, including fixtures and mirrors, and damp mopping of floors
- replenishing paper and soap products in the restrooms, as needed

Additionally, uncarpeted (VCT) floors are cleaned and mopped, and carpeted floors vacuumed, twice a week. Spot cleaning for stained carpet areas is performed as needed during those twice weekly floor cleaning sessions.

If at any time you have concerns, wish to share comments or suggestions about your janitorial service, or need to make special arrangements for any reason, please contact your firm's designated cleaning company directly. To confirm the contact information for your firm's cleaning company, please either refer to your welcome packet or reach out to your account manager. You may also contract directly with the cleaning company for additional services, at your firm's expense.

Recycling

Client firms are responsible for recycling all materials other than standard office paper. Paper and cardboard that will not fit into a standard desk-side wastebasket must be broken down and placed in the cardboard recycling dumpsters located on the loading dock at each building.

Glass, metal, and plastic recyclables should be deposited in the single-system recycling dumpster located on the concrete pad adjacent to Big Sky Bread Company. Please thoroughly rinse all materials prior to recycling them, and take care when transporting recyclables through the building to avoid staining or damaging the flooring.
