Grant Cycle Update: The annual <u>Cummings \$30 Million Grant Program</u> continues to draw a large, competitive pool of applicants, with local nonprofits collectively filing 703 proposals for consideration last month. Each of these organizations is vying to receive one of the 150 grants to be awarded next June.

The applicants represent a wide variety of causes, including education, food insecurity, elder care, social justice, and, newly eligible this year, several <u>causes related to the environment</u>.

The Foundation's team of volunteer reviewers is now evaluating the proposals to determine which will be invited to advance to the full
